Town Hosts Community Workshop

Topics: Bluffton Home Series, Neighborhood Assistance & Heirs' Property

The Town of Bluffton's Affordable Housing Committee is hosting a free workshop February 26 to highlight Town-sponsored programs which offer assistance to residents regarding home repairs, heirs' property assistance and pre-approved housing designs and financial assistance within the Bluffton Home Series.

The Community Workshop will be held at the Rotary Community Center, Monday, February 26 from 6 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. Town staff members, elected officials and representatives from local organizations will be available to answer questions regarding these programs.

“Local housing issues are a top priority for Town Council and staff,” Fred Hamilton, Town councilmember and chairman of the Town's Affordable Housing Committee, said. “We hope this workshop will help educate our residents about Town programs which are available to improve living conditions or provide guidance through complex housing issues.”

Within the workshop, Town staff members will give details about the Town's Neighborhood Assistance Program. Among the program's benefits, income

qualified residents can receive help with removing unwanted items from their property such as old cars, trash and appliances. Income-qualified residents can also apply for financial assistance for home repairs.

The workshop will also address issues related to heirs' property. Representatives from the Charleston-based Center for Heirs' Property Preservation will be available to answer questions and give guidance to those who are working to obtain a clear title for their family's property.

“If you are unable to attend the meeting or if you have other housing or property-related questions, please always feel free to call us at Town Hall,” Heather Colin, director of the Town's growth management department, said. “We have a dedicated staff member who focuses on these issues and we are here to assist.”
